


HEATING AND COOLING AT A COMFIER COST.

They will:

- Ensure the system is operating safely

- Inspect ductwork at furnace for leaks and disconnections

- · Clean and adjust critical components
- Check the thermostat and safety controls
- · Perform a carbon monoxide test
