## Energy Efficiency Rebate Programs: How To Participate.

### 01 Use a Contractor in Our Approved Network

Select a contractor from our participating network at [WGSmartSavings.com/FindaContractor](https://www.wgsmartavings.com/FindaContractor) and consult about the type of equipment you intend to purchase and your interest in a Washington Gas rebate.

### 02 Purchase Eligible High-Efficiency Equipment

Choose qualifying, brand-new, high-efficiency equipment, such as heating systems, water heaters, smart thermostats and other approved equipment. To confirm your equipment meets the minimum efficiency requirements for a rebate, visit [WGSmartSavings.com/MDPrograms](https://www.wgsmartavings.com/MDPrograms).

### 03 Check if Your Equipment Meets the Efficiency Standard

Look for efficiency ratings such as SEER2, HSPF2, AFUE or UEF on product labels or spec sheets. Confirm with your contractor that the equipment you intend to purchase suits your unique needs and meets the required efficiency standards to receive a rebate.

### 04 Schedule Your Installation

An authorized contractor installs your qualifying equipment on your behalf.

### 05 Have Your Contractor Submit the Rebate

He or she will submit the rebate application and supplemental documentation on your behalf.

### 06 Receive Your Rebate

Rebates are issued by mail directly to customers. Most rebates are processed within a few weeks.

## Financing Opportunities for Energy Efficiency Upgrades

The EmPOWER Maryland programs offer financing opportunities for Maryland residents to purchase qualifying high-efficiency equipment.

Customers can get a preferred interest rate on their loans through the **Clean Energy Advantage Program**.

- Check with your contractor to see if they have any available financing plans.

**Important Notice:** Maryland HB 1532, Utility RELIEF (Reducing Energy Load Inflation for Everyday Families) Act, 2026 Leg., 445th Sess. (Md. 2026) eliminates gas utilities from the EmPOWER Maryland program effective in 2026, necessitating the termination of gas-related programs by year-end. The program will remain unchanged until Dec. 31, 2026. Act promptly to get preapproval before the cutoff to ensure eligibility.
